Welfare for Children

The City of Urasoe, like other muncipalities in Japan, subsidizes many services for families with young children. Although not part of the official education system, these are government-run programs designed to lighten the burden of child rearing by providing child care services, financial assistance, and classes for parents.

Daycare Centers (Hoiku-sho 保育所)

There are 32 certified daycare centers for children ages 5 months to 5 years old and 19 regional daycare centers for children ages 5 months to 2 years old. Although there are both public and corporate daycare centers, every center has the same mission, fees, and hours. Generally, center hours are from 7:00AM to 6:00PM, and their fees depend on the families' income.

Registration for daycare centers tend to open in the fall. Details about registration can be found in the October edition of the Urasoe monthly newsletter. While applications are accepted outside of the fall, please note that acceptance rates are low and your child will be placed on a waiting list. For families interested in registering their child into a daycare center, please consult the Infant Welfare Section at City Hall.

- Document Proving "Need for Daycare Services"

Only guardians that cannot provide care for their child at home can apply for registration (document proving guardian's need for daycare services required). Once the need for daycare services disappears, you will be unable to leave your child in daycare.

Youth Centers (Jidō Sentā 児童センター)

There are eleven Youth Centers in Urasoe for children ages 0-18. (Children ages four and under must attend events with a parent). These centers are places where children can play after school and on weekends in a supervised environment. Registration of your child is free, and all that is required is the completion of a registration form and a brief sign-in upon each visit. There are often planned events, such as dodge ball, picnics, small festivals, and sports competitions. The centers are a good place for your children to meet local Japanese kids. For specific information, please inquire at the center. Facilities usually include a library, video room, and gymnasium with basketball hoops, badminton, and ping-pong facilities.

The Child's Welfare Section offers several types of financial assistance for families with young children. Benefits are limited to families with an income under a certain amount.

① Childcare Allowance (Jidō Teate 児童手当)

If the qualifications for receiving benefits change due to child birth or moving into Urasoe, etc., you are required to apply directly at the Child's Welfare Section at City Hall to receive childcare allowance. Please apply within 15 days after giving birth or moving out, etc. You will be unable to receive allowance for months of late application.

② Medical Expense Allowance for Infants and Children (Kodomo Iryōhi Josei こども医療費助成)

Applicable persons include guardians of children from 0 years old to junior high school, children enrolled in health insurance, and persons registered in the Urasoe Basic Residence Registry System.

③ Child Support Allowance (Jidō Fuyō Teate 児童扶養手当)

Financial support for children younger than 18 years old living in single-parent households and children not brought up by their parents. Children who bear a moderate or higher degree disability may receive financial support until they turn 20 years old.
